The Konan University Institute for Language and Culture invites applications for three fulltime positions (non-tenured, initial three-year contract renewable for up to an additional two years by mutual agreement) of English Instructor beginning in April of 2019. Applicants should be native speakers of English or have linguistic and cultural ability that is nearly native. While not required, conversational ability in Japanese is preferred. Applicants must currently be residing in Japan.

- 4. Position title: Fixed-Term Instructor of English as a Foreign Language
- **5.** Length of contract: Initial three-year contract renewable up to an additional two years by mutual agreement.
- 6. Duties:
 - Teaching 10 *koma* (90 minutes each) of English language and culture classes per week (College English, Intermediate and Advanced levels). Most of these classes are in the English Intensive Course (EIC) program for students aiming to study abroad.
 - Providing individualized guidance and assistance to students
 - Planning and conducting various activities and events in Konan's Language Loft (self-access learning center)
 - Various other education-related duties including proctoring for final exams and university entrance exams
 Note: The number of actual classroom teaching hours may be reduced

<u>Note</u>: The number of actual classroom teaching hours may be reduced depending on the amount of Loft duties.

7. Work days and hours:

- 1) As a rule, instructors will work 5 days per week. However, when needed, they may occasionally be asked to work on off-days.
- 2) As a rule, instructors will be on duty for 40 hours per week.
- 8. Employment criteria: Qualified candidates will fulfill the following criteria:
 - 1) Be a native speaker of English, or, be able to speak English at a nearly native level.
 - 2) Possess a master's degree (or higher) in TESOL or a related field. A master's degree from a university in an English-speaking country is desirable.
 - 3) At least two years of university level teaching experience is desirable, or what could be considered an equivalent level of teaching experience.
 - 4) A strong awareness of Konan University's language and cultural education
 - 5) Ability to understand and actively conform one's teaching practices to the founding educational philosophy of Konan University
- 9. Employment location: Konan University Okamoto campus (Higashinada ward, Kobe city)
- 10. Commencement of employment date: April 1, 2019
- **11. Application submission deadline**: All documents must arrive by November 22, 2018 (Strictly enforced. Candidates are advised to send application documents well in advance of the deadline to ensure they arrive on time.)

*Educational history after high school graduation must be included. *Include your email address and list of any academic honors received. *Attach a portrait photograph.

- 2) All graduation diplomas and certificates related to educational history starting from the university undergraduate level (copies are admissible)
- 3) A short essay (about 800 words) on your views regarding university English education in Japan
- 4) An original 90-minute sample lesson plan for a university English class that can also be used in a demonstration lesson at the interview
- 5) Two letters of recommendation including the names, institutional affiliations and contact information of the referees
- 6) Up to 3 academic publications (not required)
- 7) Any certificates or diplomas indicating proficiency in Japanese, English, or another second language
 - At the interview, candidates will be expected to discuss their views of our university founder's educational philosophy (<u>http://www.konan-u.ac.jp/gakuen/hirao/index.html</u>). At the end of the selection process, the successful candidates will need to submit those views in writing.
 - Successful candidates will also need to submit a recent health check report.

 A shortlist of candidates will be selected based on examination of the application documents. Each of these candidates will give a thirty-minute demonstration lesson, followed by an interview conducted by the selection committee. These interviews will be held on Saturday December 8 and Sunday December 9, 2018.
