My research used open questionnaires followed by extensive oral interviews and follow-up correspondence (email and postal) to record in detail the memories of several Japanese Canadian exiles. Based on this research, I constructed and discussed their life histories focusing especially on the period following their deportation to Japan,

their adjustment to Japanese language and culture, their employment history, why they either stayed in Japan permanently or returned to Canada, their present sense of national and cultural identity, etc.). I have published 4 papers in the Journal of the Institute for Language and Culture, and shorter nonacademic versions on Discover Nikkei, a website of
