Japanese & International Students, Let's Work Together!

Japan faces frequent natural disasters, such as earthquakes and floods.

On January 15, 2025 the probability of a massive Nankai Trough earthquake occurring within the next 30 years was raised to approximately 80%, making it a real and imminent risk.

This project aims to develop disaster education and communications tool to help foreign residents understand evacuation information.

As we mark the 30th anniversary of the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake, this project promotes phase-free utilization for a safer, multicultural society.



1 Provide foreigners with disaster preparedness knowledge through community interaction while developing the "BOSAI Communication Card" for disaster communication".

※ In disaster situations, Wi-Fi may be unavailable, making translation apps useless. We will develop a physical communication tool that can be carried as a safety measure.

2 We will explore disaster map training using the "BOSAI Communication Card".

※ By practicing regularly, we can ensure smooth use during actual disasters. (Phase-Free Preparedness)
