WHAT ARE THE COSTS ?

- › The program fee is CAD \$1,950 (plus applicable taxes) which includes registration, placement test, tuition, classroom materials, three themed lunches and a farewell reception, afternoon activities, weekend excursions, and OPUS transportation card.
- › Students live with a local family. The homestay fee is around CAD \$1,400 (tax included) which includes airport transfers, private room, two students per family, and all meals.
- › You must arrange your own flights and medical insurance.

WHAT ARE THE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS ?

- › English language skills minimum requirements: TOEFL ITP 460 / TOEFL iBT 48 / TOEIC 505 / IELTS 4.5
- › No previous knowledge of French is required.
- › This program is for adult second language learners.
- › Students should arrive on Saturday, August 5, 2023.
