Position Details:

Employment is at Konan University's main campus in the Okamoto area of Kobe. Konan University is a private 4-year institution with approximately 8,500 students. The Institute for Language and Culture provides language courses for all of Konan's departments and a special intensive English program for highly motivated students, many of whom plan to study abroad. The intensive classes mainly consist of 20 or fewer students. The primary duty of this position is to teach English classes, but assisting students beyond the classroom by providing learning guidance and other supportive services is also important.

Instructors work in a team situation under the supervision of experienced faculty, and also have tutoring duties in Konan's Language LOFT, our self-access learning center for English study. The regular teaching load is 10 classes of 90 minutes per week each term, but that number may be reduced by one or two depending on how many shifts the instructor is scheduled to work in the LOFT each term.

Most classes are taught as intensive program courses that meet twice per week, while others are regular English courses that meet once per week. The annual salary ranges from $\pm 4,500,000$ to $\pm 6,000,000$. Modest allowances for educational research and housing costs are provided. Health insurance is partially subsidized and extended to dependents living in Japan.
